Jocelyne replied that it was because of frost - it's dangerous - and she said that it is a regulation in all schools in Ontario Was the school closure for bad weather announced on Viamonde's website? Jocelyne said it was announced via social media but that the Board recently redid their website so it was possible that it was missed on the website. 20 min for lunch is a little tight - possible to extend it? Jocelyne replied no, because the teachers need an uninterrupted break of 40 min. She said she has asked teachers to give children more time to eat after 20 mins if necessary and possible.
